All categories except Professionals and Collegiate must help at a competition or pay a \$200 buy-out fee. All Glenwood members will receive a credit to purchase Glenwood logo wear.
- 7. <u>Non-Compliant members.</u> We have 5 families that have been turned into USFS. They will not be allowed to join any USFS club until they pay the \$150 volunteer fee to Glenwood.
- 8. <u>Aspire Membership.</u> We are continuing to offer to pay the membership for Aspire members where the rink has an Aspire program. We will pay memberships for up to 20 per rink. Aspire members are not registered through the portal that all other members are registered under. The Aspire program has 3 parts On Ice classes, Off ice instruction and Parent Education.
