In addition to the above requirements, all coaches will be required to participate in their choice of continuing education programming annually, included, at no additional charge, as part of their Coach I.C.E. membership. The Core Certification is a once-in-a-career certification required before joining Coach I.C.E., for the first time. Certified coaches who have met all of the Coach Compliance requirements will be displayed in a searchable directory on the landing page of Members Only. Click on "COACH DIRECTORY" (Appears July 1, 2024)

*The Coach Core Certification is a once-in-a-career online course divided into five sections reflecting the core values of U.S. Figure Skating: Community, Resilience, Integrity, Respect, and Excellence. These sections feature modules that cover the key fundamentals that every figure skating coach should understand such as Athlete Health and Well-Being, Creating a Positive Sport Experience, Professionalism, Delivery of Feedback, Growth and Development, Training Basics and General Technique Concepts. (Note: Completion of this certification demonstrates a coach's understanding of the topics above, it does not ensure compliance with the U.S. Figure Skating Rules and policies).
